

Dear Parents,

Greetings!

In the wake of recent incidents that have struck the Student Community, we understand that you are quite concerned about your child's safety within the school premises.

Here are a few of the safety measures adopted by us:

1. We have already deployed maids to check the entry and exit into the washrooms. Also CCTV cameras too, are strategically positioned to keep a check on the entry/exit points of the washrooms.
2. There is no access of drivers and conductors in the Academic block. They have been allotted separate washrooms and water points outside the school campus.
3. CCTV cameras have been installed in the rooms, corridors and GPS enabled school buses. They are also checked from time to time to see their functioning.
4. From time to time, we have been conducting sessions on safety measures and sex education for students by various agencies like POSCO and also the school counselor.
5. We have also been conducting special sessions for our support staff i.e. maids, drivers/conductors and peons to apprise them of the safety guidelines and the proper conduct to be followed according to school norms by the school counselor and POSCO.
6. The documents of all our support staff members have already been updated with us & have been sent for police verification.
7. As per your suggestions, we shall ensure that all repair, construction and maintenance work will be undertaken after the school hours.

We request the parents to kindly extend complete support & cooperation in order to ensure the safety of the children.

POINTS TO NOTE.

- a. Make sure that you drop/pick up your ward from in front of the school gate only.
- b. Students shall not be permitted to enter the school premises before 7:20 am/8:40 am (for Pre-primary students).
- c. In case your ward forgets her/his tiffin, water bottle or any other stationery material, kindly do not come personally/send someone to drop the same as under such circumstances, we shall not be able to verify the credentials of the person & we shall be forced to send the material back home.

Adopting Strict Safety measures might make all the procedures a little delayed, so our heartfelt request to all the parents is to remain patient & cooperate with school authorities to provide safe & secure environs to the students.
