





Hybrid classroom system facilitates simultaneous online-offline classes

Gurukul Global School, Chandigarh, introduced Hybrid Classroom System, the first of its kind in the tricity, which would facilitate running online-offline classes simultaneously.

In a challenging situation, where even though the Chandigarh Administration has allowed students from class IX to XII to attend school, while parents being apprehensive want them to continue with online classes, the school came up with a hybrid solution to conduct both online and offline studies. With the help of IT professionals from an MNC tech company and audio-visual experts, the school got a custom designed Hybrid Classroom System wherein the student sitting at home can ask questions and the teacher will be able to see



and hear that student and vice versa. Under this Asynchronous Learning System, students sitting at home would be able to see whatever is happening in the classroom, whatever is being written on the smart board by the teacher, via the multi-screen setup. The school had to work with IT professionals to make sure that this

system works even at low internet speed to ensure that the audio-visual quality does not fall short. In this regard, principal Nina Pandey said, "We are proud that we are the first school in the tricity in which Hybrid Technology was introduced so that students sitting at home and in classrooms study together."

Under the hybrid system, the school has installed two-way high-quality speakers with wireless mikes and smart boards integrated with Microsoft Teams. The students studying online from their homes will be able to listen to the teacher with the same clarity as listening to the student sitting in the classroom and also clear doubts. The multi-screen setup will enable the student sitting at home to see the teacher's writing on the smart board, which will also appear on the screen of the laptop or mobile device being used by the student.
